BELGIAN LUXEMBOURG TRADE ECONOMIC MISSION TO NOVGOROD THE GREAT (RUSSIA)









28 - 29 MAY 2018, BRUSSELS

NOVGOROD THE GREAT, CCBLR (BRUSSELS & MOSCOW) TRADE MISSION

With the support of Local Administration, Agency for development and Chamber of Commerce of Novgorod

Novgorod has connections to Moscow (531 km) and St. Petersburg (189 km) with Federal M10 and High Speed Trains. The main industries of the local economy are chemical, metallurgical, wood products industry, paper and pulp industries, agriculture, food & fishery industry, digital economy. Development of transports, geographic location, special conditions for investment projects and tourisme are attractive trumps for this part of Russia.

Veliky Novgorod is one of the most ancient cities of Russia. Its history dates back to the middle of the 9th century.

Founded as a political centre of Slavic and Fino-Ugric tribes who controlled vast territories stretching up from the Baltic lands in the West to the Ural Mountains in the East, Veliky Novgorod was the second most important centre in Kievan Rus (the first organized state located on the lands of modern Russia, Ukraine and Belarus). It is believed that when the state of Kievan Rus was still being established, the Novgorodians invited the Scandinavian prince Rurik to keep law and order there. It is the Rurik dynasty that ruled the Russian lands for more than 750 years before the Romanovs ascended to the throne.

Due to its geographical location, Novgorod also operated as an international trade centre on the Baltic-Volga commercial route that tied northern Europe with Asia.

The city also played a big role in spreading and promoting the Orthodoxy. It is in the middle of the 12th century when the Novgorod Bishops were given the status of Archbishops which enabled them to become the most powerful in the Russian Orthodoxy. Novgorod was one of Russia's major centres of literacy and publishing.

The history of Veliky Novgorod is also closely linked to the republican and democratic traditions. In the period of 1136 -1478 all important decisions on city's life were made by the "veche" - an ancient parliament that included representatives from various Novgorodian tribes. The distinctive political structure and historical territorial independence has enabled Veliky Novgorod's culture to flourish.

Nowadays, Veliky Novgorod is known as one of the major cultural centres of the country. The city is interesting for its architectural and historical traditions. The Novgorodian school of icon-painting, fresco painting, jeweller's and decorative applied arts are famous all over the world.

The city has direct railway passenger connections with Moscow (Leningradsky Rail Terminal, by night trains), St. Petersburg (Moscow Rail Terminal and Vitebsk Rail Terminal, by suburban trains), Minsk (Belarus) (Minsk Passazhirsky railway station, by night trains) and Murmansk.

Geachte mevrouw, mijnheer,

De stad Antwerpen organiseert samen met haar partners Port of Antwerp en Antwerp World Diamond Centre een gezamenlijke missie naar Rusland (Sint-Petersburg en Moskou) van 22 tot 28 april 2018, aangevoerd door burgemeester Bart De Wever. Formele aanleiding is de zestigste verjaardag van de officiële vriendschapsband tussen Antwerpen en Sint-Petersburg.

Het stadsbestuur van Antwerpen hecht veel belang aan het ondersteunen van Antwerpse organisaties en ondernemingen in het buitenland. Dat resulteerde in 2014, 2016 en 2017 al in succesvolle missies naar Azië en Canada. In 2018 richten we onze blik opnieuw oostwaarts.

Sint-Petersburg en Moskou: aantrekkelijke partners

Sint-Petersburg en Moskou vormen de belangrijkste economische centra van Rusland: beide steden zijn innovatieknooppunten met transparante investeringsregels en taksvrije economische zones. Sint-Petersburg is bovendien dé culturele hoofdstad van Rusland, met 6,5 miljoen toeristen in 2015.

Voor Port of Antwerp is Sint-Petersburg een belangrijke handelspartner, goed voor 12 miljoen ton goederenverkeer. Na een grote havenmissie in 2015 biedt de stadsmissie van 2018 een uitstekende opvolggelegenheid.

Ook voor de diamantsector is Rusland een positieve keuze. Als belangrijke speler op vlak van ruwe diamant neemt Rusland een derde van de wereldproductie voor zijn rekening, en 84% van de ruwe diamanten passeert via Antwerpen.

De missie zal naast Sint-Petersburg ook Moskou bezoeken, een belangrijke regio met heel wat groeipotentieel. We besteden er specifiek aandacht aan nieuwe technologieën, digitale sectoren en start-ups. Een gezamenlijke aanwezigheid opent deuren voor zowel bedrijven als onderzoeksinstellingen.

The Eastern Economic Forum was established by Decree of the Russian President Vladimir Putin on 19 May 2015 to support the economic development of Russia's Far East and to expand international cooperation in the Asia-Pacific region.

The Forum has established itself as a major international communications platform and key event for business leaders and top political figures from around the world. The Forum helps to strengthen ties within the international investment community and provides a comprehensive expert assessment of the Russian Far East's economic potential.



FORUM

There are three key aspects to EEF:

- demonstrating the investment potential of various industries located in the Russian Far East, from agriculture and tourism to heavy industry and high-tech manufacturing
- discussing the various tax and other incentives offered to investors by the state
- searching for new ways to foster the economic development of the Russian Far East and the potential for integration into the economy of the Asia-Pacific region

Russian seafood delegation to take part in key global seafood events in 2018 . BRUSSELS , April 24-26



Russia's Agency for Fisheries has announced the list of

industry events its representatives will attend in 2018, and has named Seafood Expo Global and its own International Seafood Forum as its top two priorities.

The International Seafood Forum will be held in St. Petersburg, Russia, 13-15 September 2018. The event was set up by the agency in 2017 to create a platform for presenting Russian fisheries' interests and needs to the international seafood community and to find partners for cooperation at a governmental level. Last year's event was attended by more than 1,600 participants from 20 countries.

In 2018, the forum will see a wider membership of regulators, experts, and global companies, the agency announced. More than 40 percent of its exhibition space had already been booked by more than 300 companies from around 50 countries. DSI, Carsoe, Flottweg, Baader, Rolls-Royce, Marel, Amof Fjell and Optimar are among those confirmed to attend the show.

In 2017, Russia pushed to increase its presence at Seafood Expo Global, held annually in Brussels, Belgium. This year, Russian companies will take part in the forum for the third consecutive year to reach out to international clients and seek out informed perspectives on technologies, which the national seafood industry lacks, according to the agency.

In a press release, the agency said it considers Seafood Expo Global, to be held in Brussels, Belgium, from 24 to 26 April 2018, a "very important event" that brings together leaders from seafood industry from across the world to discuss common problems and exchange experience.

"This is a superb marketing tool for Russian companies to showcase its production at a minimal cost through participation in the Russian national stand, with the area of the stand 2017 being enlarged six-fold in comparison to 2016," the agency said.

Other events on the agency's list include the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum from 24 to 26 May, where a special industry exposition will be organized; China Fisheries and Seafood Expo 2018 in Qindgao, China, from 7 to 9 November; and the East Economic Forum in Vladivostok, Russia, on 6 and 7 September.
